We turn old rubbish into something new – like a plastic water bottle into a new toy.

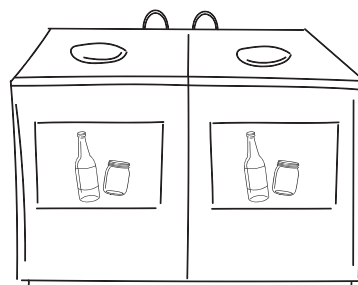
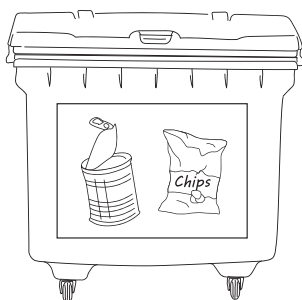
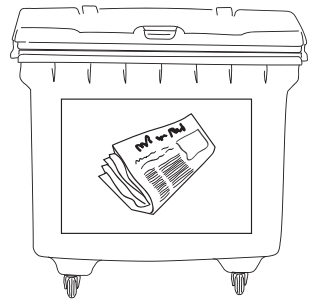
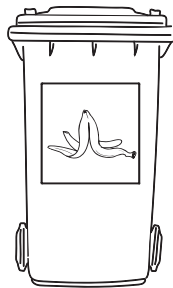
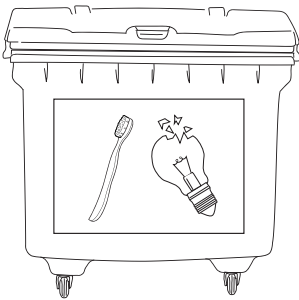
